SYNOPSIS: Winner of 3 Tony Awards and 4 Drama Desk Awards, Lend Me A Tenor is a hilarious, fast paced comedy! Saunders, the general manager of the Cleveland Grand Opera Company, is primed to welcome world-famous singer Tito Merelli, known as II Stupendo, the greatest tenor of his generation, to appear for one night only as the star of the opera. Tito arrives late, and through a hilarious series of mishaps, he is given a double dose of tranquilizers and passes out. His pulse is so low that Saunders and his assistant Max believe he's dead - and in a frantic attempt to salvage the evening, Saunders persuades Max to get into Merelli's costume and fool the audience into thinking he's II Stupendo. Max succeeds and lives up to his idol, but Merelli regains consciousness and gets into the identical costume, ready to perform. Now two opera singers are running around in the same costume and two women are running around in lingerie, each thinking she is with Il Stupendo. A sensation on Broadway and in London's West End, this madcap, screwball comedy is guaranteed to leave audiences teary-eyed with laughter. AGES: We recommend this show for ages 15 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level. DETAILS: By today's standards, this show would probably be rated PG-13. This is an adult themed show with some characters cursing. Characters are also shown drinking alcohol on stage and there is sexual innuendo throughout the play. A couple costumes may be somewhat revealing. \*Trigger warning: there is a character who says he wants to kill himself and then other characters mistakenly think he has committed suicide. LENGTH: Approximately  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  hours with an intermission.
