SYNOPSIS:

STEEL MAGNOLIAS is the story of a group of local women in a modern-day Louisiana town. This close-knit circle of friend's gossip and giggle at Truvy's Beauty Shop as they lean on one another for support through life's tragedies and triumphs. Filled with humor and heartbreak, these women make us laugh and cry as the realities of their lives unfold in the tiny parish of Chinquapin.

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 12 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

The sound of gunshots and explosives are used. There is very brief talk of female and male forms of birth control and sexual innuendo when there is discussion of events surrounding a wedding. There is discussion about a character's announcement to his parents that he is gay. There is sexual innuendo regarding late night visits from a gentleman caller to a character's home, that in actuality are very innocent. The word "damn" is said once during a diabetic episode. The word "hell" is used twice in a humorous discussion. The term "smart ass" is used in a humorous discussion. Trigger warning: One of the main characters dies and grief is the focus of a scene. By today's movie rating standards, this play would be rated PG.
