- SYNOPSIS:** GRUMPY OLD MEN is the story of two aging men, Max and John, neighbors who have been feuding for most of their lives. Invigorated by their shared affection for their new neighbor across the street, the beautiful, eccentric, and charming Ariel, they face-off as romantic rivals until their hilarious shenanigans finally bring about a resolution to their long-standing differences. Based on the 1993 film, which starred Jack Lemmon, Walter Matthau, and Ann-Margret, this stage adaptation captures the lovably crotchety characters through twinkling humor, great songs, and the affectionate depiction of a small town that feels like home to everyone.
- AGES:** We recommend this show for ages 13 and up. There is adult content detailed below and the subject matter may not hold the attention of a young patron. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgment when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.
- DETAILS:** This show has adult themes and subjects, such as the sex lives of senior adults. There are numerous (mild) curse words and insults between the two sparring lead characters (such as boob, bastard, dumbass, etc.). There is sexual innuendo in several jokes. There is a song about the “facts of life” including discussion of intimate relations. There is a conversation that is innocent but is overheard and sounds sexual in nature.
