SYNOPSIS:

"You Can't Stop The Beat" of this Broadway Musical Comedy! Take a trip back to 1962 with Tracy Turnblad, a big girl with even bigger hair, as she sets out to dance her way onto the popular Cory Collins show. Along the way she tries to bring about integration on the show and win the heart of the boy of her dreams. This award-winning musical phenomenon is filled with laughter, romance, and is a joyous tribute to the 60's. The winner of eight 2003 Tony Awards, including Best Musical.

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 10 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

By today's standards, this show would probably be rated PG for mild language, adult themes, and some sexual references. This show takes place in the 1960's and addresses issues including: teen rebellion, inter-racial dating, racism, integration and discrimination based on one's size. There is also discrimination and language in regards to being put in "special ed" classes. It is very similar to the musical movie starring John Travolta released in 2007 by the same name which was rated PG. There is sexual innuendo in some of the lyrics and dialogue including a reference to using protection during sex. Some of the dancing is sexually suggestive. Just as in the movie, a man will play the mother character dressed as a woman.

LANGUAGE:

This production contains some adult language that is used throughout the show.

LENGTH: Approximately 2 1/2 hours with an intermission.
