SYNOPSIS: Based on the classic Frank Capra movie, this musical version tells the story of George

Bailey. This hardworking, honest man has, in trying to help others, gotten into financial

trouble and is contemplating taking his own life. Through the angels Joseph and Clarence, we get a flashback of George's life, his family, how he meets and marries his wife, Mary, and how he saves his father's business, the Savings and Loan. We also see how he stumbles, and how he is ultimately saved when Clarence, his guardian angel,

helps him see that money is not what makes a person rich!

AGES: If given a movie rating it would probably be PG. We recommend this show for ages 10
