SYNOPSIS:

Tony's plot to murder his cheating wife Margot for her money goes awry when Margot kills her would-be assailant in self-defense. Now Tony has to improvise his plan and schemes to frame his wife for premeditated murder. Can Margot's ex-lover Max solve the mystery and discover the truth before she is hanged for the crime? DIAL "M" FOR MURDER was written by Frederick Knott and was the basis for the 1954 American crime thriller directed by Alfred Hitchcock and starring Grace Kelly. A thrilling and suspenseful murder mystery that will keep you guessing until the very last moment!

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 13 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

By today's standards if this show were given a movie rating, it would be rated PG or PG-13. There are no profanities, but the subject matter is mature. There is an intense scene in which a murder takes place on stage. Characters discuss a history of infidelity and plot murder. The characters drink alcohol and make references about drug use and drug overdose. Younger audiences may be bored with the content of the show. A harmless, theatrical "smokeless cigarette" is used.

LANGUAGE: "damned" is used once
