SYNOPSIS:

Retired brothers Jay and Sonny Allen move to central Florida with their wives, Martha and Veronica, to open a cafe. When the business starts failing and their nest egg dries up, they take drastic action to try and generate some cash. Action that includes murder for life insurance money, podcasts and baking cannabis into the appetizers to 'stimulate' business! However, when Martha's old boyfriend, detective Marty Minkoff as well as Nadia, a forty-something Latvian loan shark who Jay owes money to, arrive on the scene, things get complicated! Throw into the mix a twenty-something millennial who's never heard of Elvis Presley, but sounds and acts exactly like him, and you soon have a recipe for hilarity!

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 13 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

By today's standards, this show would probably be rated PG-13. This is an adult themed show with characters frequently discussing marriage problems, their sex lives, infidelity, gambling, money laundering and plots to murder their significant other in order to collect insurance money. There is also a moment when two of the characters get "caught in the act" and he is seen wearing only shorts and her bra is left on stage. A common comedic theme throughout is secretly baking marijuana into their recipes to drum up business. Some mild profanity and lewd language is used.

LENGTH: Approximately 2 ½ hours with an intermission.
