- SYNOPSIS:** This beloved musical based on the MGM Film pays tribute to classic Hollywood and the introduction of “talkies”. Don Lockwood, a dashing silent film star and his glamorous, on-screen partner/diva Lina Lamont are pressured by studio boss R.F. Simpson to change their silent romantic drama into a sound picture, complete with songs and dances. The only problem is that the female star has a voice that screeches like fingernails on a chalkboard. Cosmo Brown, Don’s former song and dance partner, introduces the idea of letting aspiring actress/singer, Kathy Selden, dub her singing voice for lip-synching Lina.
