SYNOPSIS:

Music, dance, laughs, and the age-old tale of Boy Meets Girl! ANYTHING GOES is a hilarious shipboard romp wrapped around one of Cole Porter's most magical scores. The S. S. American is sailing between New York and England with a comically colorful assemblage of passengers: Reno Sweeney, a popular nightclub singer and former evangelist, her pal Billy Crocker, a lovelorn Wall Street broker who has come aboard to try to win the favor of his beloved Hope Harcourt (who is engaged to another passenger, Sir Evelyn Oakleigh), and a second-rate con-man named Moonface Martin, aka "Public Enemy #13." Song, dance, and farcical antics ensue as Reno and Moonface try to help Billy win the love of his life.

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 10 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

By today's standards, if this show were given a movie rating, it would be rated PG13. There are a couple mild curse words. There is talk and innuendo about sexual relations. Some costumes may be revealing, particularly the showgirls. Some characters are shown drinking alcohol and gambling onstage. While there is no nudity, a game of strip poker is started onstage between male characters (in order to steal clothes to use as a disguise).
