

<u>SHOW CONTENT INFORMATION SHEET</u>

SYNOPSIS:

This musical adaptation of the '70s classic film is the story of a talented, streetwise kid from Brooklyn who attempts to escape his dead-end life through dancing. The score is a trip down memory lane and includes many disco-era hits by the Bee Gees. While the backdrop is bleak with racial tension, violence and rebellious teens, Tony finds a way to overcome the tragedies of his neighborhood and keep, "Stayin' Alive".

AGES:

This is an adult themed show. We recommend this show for ages 15 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:
