- SYNOPSIS:** Set on a Kansas prairie, Dorothy and her dog Toto run away from home when a neighbor tries to take her dog away. A tornado takes Dorothy and Toto to a magical land. She is helped by the Good Witch of the North, but she’s also in trouble with the Wicked Witch. Wishing to return home, Dorothy travels to Emerald City and meets up with a Scarecrow, a Tin Man and a Cowardly Lion along the way to see the Wizard. They all hope the Wizard can help them before the Wicked Witch of the West catches up with them.
- AGES:** THE WIZARD OF OZ is suitable for all ages. However, parents should know the following details to assist with their decision: 1) Miss Gulch threatens to have Toto “destroyed”/killed for biting her and 2) The Wicked Witch of the West may be scary for young children and uses many things to frighten Dorothy and her friends, including poison flowers and flying monkeys.
- DETAILS:** There will be smoke and/or haze along with loud sounds and strobe lighting for some of the scenes with the Wicked Witch of the West.
