- SYNOPSIS: Experience the sensational musical about the bespectacled, 1950's rock n' roll icon. This non-stop entertaining rock show recounts Buddy Holly's 18-month, meteoric rise to fame and the indelible impact he left on the industry after his untimely death at the age of 22. Influencing artists from The Beatles to Bruce Springsteen and plenty of musicians in between, the early rocker is immortalized in this mesmerizing musical memoir. Performances include over 20 of his greatest hits like "That'll Be the Day", "It's So Easy to Fall in Love", and "Peggy Sue", along with Ritchie Valens' "La Bamba" and The Big Bopper's "Chantilly Lace".
- AGES: We recommend this show for ages 10 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.
- **DETAILS:** By today's standards if this show were given a movie rating, it would be rated PG-13 due to some language, not content. As this is based on real people, the characters can be heard cussing at times. A character is shown drinking alcohol onstage. Because this is based on the life of the real Buddy Holly, there is a tragic element toward the end of the show.
