- SYNOPSIS:** *Sweeney Todd* has become a bloody, worldwide success since being awarded eight Tony's, including Best Musical. Stephen Sondheim's and Hugh Wheeler's thrilling, theatrical treat has simultaneously shocked, awed and delighted audiences across the world. An infamous tale, Sweeney Todd, an unjustly exiled barber, returns to nineteenth century London seeking vengeance against the lecherous judge who framed him and ravaged his young wife. The road to revenge leads Todd to Mrs. Lovett, a resourceful proprietress of a failing pie shop, above which, he opens a new barber practice. Mrs. Lovett's luck sharply shifts when Todd's thirst for blood inspires the integration of an ingredient into her meat pies that has the people of London lining up...and the carnage has only just begun! Featuring some of the most chilling music ever written for the stage, this masterpiece is sure both to thrill and delight audiences.
- AGES:** This show has adult themes. We recommend this show for ages 15 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.
- DETAILS:** This play contains adult themes and multiple depictions of murder, several with slashing of throats. There is a gunshot. A beggar woman appears to offer her services to men for money. There are unsanitary and disgusting depictions of food preparation eventually leading to using human meat in pies. There is a mimed simulation of an attack of a woman by two men. There is a line about an apparent suicide by poison. There is a line about blinding birds and then a bird is strangled. A man lusts after his underage ward beating himself to try to stop the lust, but eventually decides to try to marry her. There is a simulation of a painful tooth extraction. There several mild curse words in the show.
