SYNOPSIS:

Join us for this hilarious comedy- horror- rock musical about a hapless florist shop worker, Seymour, who stumbles across a new breed of plant he names "Audrey II" - after his coworker crush. This foul-mouthed, R&B-singing carnivore promises unending fame and fortune to the down and out Seymour as long as he keeps feeding it, BLOOD. Over time, Seymour discovers Audrey II's out of this world origins and intent towards global domination!

AGES:

DETAILS:

By today's standards, this show would probably be rated PG-13. This show contains mature themes including domestic violence, drug use and a man-eating plant. One of the characters is sadistic and demonstrates domestic abuse on his girlfriend. He also uses laughing gas to get high. The play centers around another character feeding human victims to a large plant. Seymour watches the dentist die, and does nothing about it. The character of Audrey dresses in short skirts and low-cut dresses.
