SYNOPSIS:

When Annie’s husband passes away, she and her best friend Chris concoct a bold plan to raise money for a new hospital sofa: create a charity calendar featuring the ladies of their women’s club—tastefully posing...with very little left to the imagination. What starts as an offbeat idea soon turns into an uproarious adventure as these ordinary women become accidental celebrities. Friendship is tested, secrets are revealed, and inhibitions are tossed aside in this feel-good comedy about courage, camaraderie, and discovering that it’s never too late to blossom.

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 13 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

By today’s standards, this show would probably be rated PG-13, due to adult language, humor and content. Nudity is a central element of the plot, but the audience is never shown full nudity on stage; the performers’ bodies are concealed or nudity is implied. The play centers on the diagnosis and death of a character’s husband from leukemia, and the emotional journey of dealing with grief and loss. There is alcohol use throughout the show.

LANGUAGE:

Some mild profanity and adult language is used. A list of words can be provided upon request.

LENGTH:

Approximately 2 ½ hours including an intermission.
