SYNOPSIS:

Step into the charming English countryside of the 1920s, where nothing is quite as peaceful—or as proper—as it seems. *The Cottage* follows the delightfully improper escapades of Bea and her lover Stanley, who sneak away to a secluded cottage for a weekend tryst. But their romantic getaway takes a sharp comedic turn when unexpected visitors arrive...including their respective spouses. What unfolds is a fast-paced tangle of revelations, reversals, and outrageous confessions. With every door that opens, another secret spills out—turning this quiet cottage into a whirlwind of witty barbs, mistaken assumptions, and hilariously heightened emotions.

AGES:

We recommend this show for ages 13 and up. However, parents are encouraged to use their own judgement and discretion when choosing shows for children based on their maturity and interest level.

DETAILS:

By today's standards, this show would probably be rated PG-13, due to sexual innuendo, adult themes, themes of infidelity, discussions of violence, prostitution, and moderate profanity. *The Cottage* contains sexual situations and discussions- including characters in skimpy undergarments and clothing. There is alcohol and cigarette use throughout and one character is notably drunk in one scene. One situation in which a character is having stomach issues leads to some lewd comments. There will be a gunshot during the show.

LANGUAGE:
